You also understand that interest will continue to accrue daily on the unpaid balance of the chosen loan(s). You also agree that you have read and agree to the terms of the Skip-A-Pay. Loans on payroll deduction, will have the allotted amounts (for the loan) deposited to their regular share savings upon each pay for the month in which you have requested that your payment be skipped. You understand that you can skip one monthly payment for each loan that you have outstanding. Example: If you have 2 loans, skip 1 loan in December & the other in January or both in December or both in January. **(All loans must be current to take advantage of this skip-a-payment offer.)** We must receive your request for skip a pay by the end of the month prior to due date. **Home Equity loans are not eligible to skip a payment. Trouble debt restructured loans also are not eligible.**
